






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# FOUNDER'S LETTER

Dear friends and collaborators:

We send you an affectionate greeting together with the report of the activities carried out in 2019.

I want to thank all the people who have made possible this year. To all employees and teachers who live the day to day of the field projects, the volunteers and the partners.

Thanks to the effort and dedication of more than 170 people we have managed to provide education and job opportunities for many young people whose families suffer difficult socioeconomic situations in Honduras, as well as support for projects that promote equal opportunities through training from Spain.

## HONDURAS

With the School of Glass project and our annual collaboration with the Loyola Technical Center, in 2019 we have impacted more than 410 families of 10 rural communities in the surroundings from the city of El Progreso; none of them have secondary schools and some do not even have primary schools.

We celebrate that in 2019 we signed a new agreement with Nacar Foundation and the Friends of the School of Glass School Association, creating an alliance in favor of the School of Glass project to join efforts and achieve sustainability. This year 16 young people graduated from areas of technical studies, 17 of compulsory basic education (ninth) and 8 of baccalaureate (eleventh). In addition, many others managed employment without problems.

We have also managed to give life to a new innovative project: the Solidarity Food Truck. This project has shown great ability for the dissemination of the need for educational quality in the country. It has given voice to young people themselves at the same time that it trains cooking students to carry out social projection actions in favor of older adults and children.

We have expanded the functions of the Microcredit Fund towards development,

supporting not only young entrepreneurship, but job training and community assistance, given the ongoing country circumstances. In the field of university education we have awarded a scholarship to 3 young people, two in Honduras and one in Spain, and we managed to make an alliance with the New Millennium University of Honduras to help students of the School that choose to continue university studies.

## SPAIN

In Spain, we have continued our support with AIPC Pandora in the Talent Opportunity Program, co-sponsoring 2 young people. We have also created the Recruiter's Club, a volunteer group to support Verón Foundation and we are developing the Technology Club with Tetuan Valley, in favor of the reduction of the digital divide in Honduras. We have managed international volunteering and carried out all the coordination tasks for the achievement of projects.

All of this drives us to move forward in our homework to make a world a little bit better to live in and continue to encourage our friends to be part, since it is the responsibility of us all. Civil society and businesses must join efforts to create opportunities for those who have no choice.

# SCHOOL OF GLASS

**SECTOR** · Education

**LOCATION** · Aldea El Porvenir del Norte (Camalote). El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras

**DESCRIPTION** · The Glass School of Honduras is an international cooperative educational project that was started in 2009 and which still stands as continued help. Since 2015 the school is located in Aldea El Porvenir del Norte (Camalote), north of the city of El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras. Its objective is to train young people to have access to a job and a decent life.

The School of Glass cares for young people with scarce resources from rural areas, which otherwise would not have access to an education.

The School of Glass offers young Hondurans three years of professional training

in Glass Crafts and in Kitchen and Tourism, with the certification of CONEANFO (Commission

Institute for the Development of Alternative Not formal Education). At the same time, young people pass exams of the Basic Cycle (regulated education) thanks to the agreement with IHER (Honduran Institute for Radio Education). The School of Glass opens its doors on Saturdays for young people who want to study high school

and for other educational and non educational activities.

In parallel, students under 18 who by law are not allowed to work, can come to the school and continue their studies in the area of specialization corresponding to the technical career that they chose.

# SCHOOL FOR MOTHERS AND FATHERS

**SECTOR** · Education and community aid

**LOCATION** · El Porvenir del Norte Village (Camalote). El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras

**DESCRIPTION** · The School of Mothers and Fathers was born under the School of Glass project of Honduras, to make families aware of the importance of education in the future of their children and themselves. We also give talks and tips to help them improve their quality of life.

The School of Mothers and Fathers performs between one and two sessions per month in which orientation talks such as equality and coexistence at home, importance of education for your children, how to face conflicts in the family etc. Craft activities are carried out so fathers and mothers can sell them and have an extra income for the family.

# UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

**SECTOR** · Education

**LOCATION** · El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras and Madrid Spain.

## DESCRIPTION

### A. UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS OF THE SCHOOL OF GLASS

Since we started to collaborate and work with the Association Friends of the School of Glass, we saw that there were young people, who after graduation, had a desire to go to University. This is something exceptional for young people of this profile in Honduras and with their living circumstances. And we are proud for having instilled in them the value of effort and the desire for a better future.

In 2018, 26% of the young students from the School of Glass started a university career.

In 2019 we have received more requests for higher studies and 4 of them came from

young women. This data is a clear symptom of improvement and social advancement.

Since 2016 we have given three university scholarships.

In 2019, together with the Friends of the School of Glass, we have started a protocol of agreements with universities to support young people with half scholarships becoming facilitators since there are resources in the country to access university that we can take advantage of.

With the help of university teachers and other collaborators, orientation actions will be carried out so they know the possibilities of access, existing scholarships from universities and the State Program 20-20. We will also give preparation sessions to help students with their public university admission test.

### B. UNIVERSITY HALF SCHOLARSHIP FOR A YOUNG HONDURAN IN SPAIN

In 2018 we gave a scholarship to a young man so that he could fulfill his dream; in his own words “ have my own car company”. His father is a mechanic in El Progreso, Honduras, and has his own workshop. They are hardworking family who is committed to the education of their children.

Thanks to the recommendation of the Honorary Consul from Spain in Honduras we met this

case and we are supporting this young man with half scholarship to study Automotive Engineering. In 2019 he entered the Motor & Sports Institute from the Francisco de Vitoria University of Madrid Spain.

The conditions you must meet to maintain the half scholarship are good grades, support Fundación Verón in whatever way they can and get involved in all our events.

The other half scholarship is covered by the state program of scholarships abroad in Honduras, thanks to this young man’s profile, high capacity and commitment.

# SUMMER EDUCATIONAL VOLUNTEERING PROGRAM IN HONDURAS

**SECTOR** · Education

**LOCATION** · El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras

**DESCRIPTION** · In 2019 we carried out 2 volunteering programs in favor of the Glass School of Glass project and the Loyola Technical Center in El Progreso, Honduras.

## **SCHOOL OF GLASS EDUCATIONAL VOLUNTEERING PROGRAM OF COOKING AND TOURISM SCHOOL**

A volunteer went to Honduras for a 3 weeks period and, together with the school team, taught Cuisine and Tourism. During the opening of the Solidarity Food Truck, she also helped shaping a program of dual Professional Training including a subject on human development.

## **ENTREPRENEURSHIP VOLUNTEERING**

During 1 week a volunteer supported the School of Glass and the Loyola Technical Center in training for entrepreneurship and empowering the teachers of these schools to encourage entrepreneurship in their students. This has been the starting point to create a pilot project in 2020 called the Technology Club, which aims to develop learning in new digital tools and allow self-employment thanks to it, and help bridge the existing digital divide in Honduras.

# COLLABORATION WITH AIPC PANDORA

## TALENT OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

**SECTOR** · Education

**DESCRIPTION** · This is an innovating socio-educational program from AIPC Pandora and Fundación Tomillo. They train and act as tutors for 3 years to young people with proven talent and reduced opportunities due to their socio-economic situation.

The first group of Talent Opportunity started in November 2018 and Fundación Verón is one of the organizations that support with scholarships. Young people start this program in 4th Grade, it takes three years then to enter university to become leaders capable of dealing with current challenges from our society, locally and globally.

Talent Opportunity inspires and helps young people to recognize their talent and vocation and empowers them to achieve their dreams. Hoping to make them leaders to build a better and fairer world, more sustainable and in peace.

During the academic year, they receive English lessons, values and global skills towards their personal, academic and professional full development. And in the summer they make a special trip. This summer they participate in a volunteer program of cultural immersion in the High Atlas of Morocco and in Bangalore, India.

In 2019, Fundación Verón has co financed 2 scholarships: Rofaida and Ismael. Both value that on this first year of the program they both have increased by an average of more than 80% their English skills, and have acquired values such as emotional intelligence, empathy, global vision, teamwork and leadership, critical thinking, flexibility, responsibility and communication skills.

During the academic year they had:

- AProject Based Learning, in English. Two evenings a week; 2.5 h / afternoon.
- ATraining in Global Citizenship, with experts. 1 Saturday a month.
- AIndividualized tutorials.
- ACultural outings



# MICROCREDITS

**SECTOR** · Labor Insertion, Entrepreneurship and Community Assistance

**LOCATION** · El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras.

**DESCRIPTION** · The Social Support Fund from Fundación Verón, previously known as a Fund for Young Entrepreneurs, now offers help for three areas:

- 1. Young entrepreneurship**
- 2. Job Training**
- 3. Community Assistance**

How does it work? This fund is aimed at young people of scarce resources who wish to undertake a business, carry out training focused on employment or in need of social support. We have created this fund in Honduras with the Friends of the School of Glass Association, which works especially for the support and good operation of the School of Glass in Honduras.

The fund works through microcredits, and is nourished by the returns. This project started in 2016 and, for the moment, works at zero interest. For each type of agreement there is a program that details the conditions, access requirements and

commitments and acquired responsibilities; a compromise agreement is made between the parts detailing the commitment for return payment.

**DESCRIPTION** · The Territorial Employment Board is developed at country level through municipalities. Those involved are the Labor and Social Security Secretariat of Honduras with the European Union through Euro + Labor, the Municipality of El Progreso, the non-profit organizations and several businesses.

The EURO + LABOR program aims to strengthen institutional decent work and opportunities for youth employment in Honduras. This project is especially aimed at young people with technical training, ages 17 to 40 years.

As Fundación Verón and Friends of the Glass School we are integrated in the Territorial Employment Board. The School of Glass project works directly with people and our objective is to help them get decent jobs or start their own business. Our goals are education, decent job and social development.

## TECHNOLOGY CLUB: FIRST CONTACT

**SECTOR** · Job placement and Education

**LOCATION** · School of Glass. Aldea El Porvenir del Norte (Camalote). El Progreso, Honduras.

**DESCRIPTION** · In 2019 we started work in a one-year educational program, since it was evaluated that the level of young people regarding the use of the Internet and digital tools is too low. The goal is to start this pilot project in 2020. This work is carried out thanks to the alliance between Tetuan Valley and Fundación Verón.

We want to create a Technology Club so that the youth of the School of Glass can develop their digital skills, have the ability to work remotely in the future and foster their own projects.

We will encourage proactivity, curiosity, research and self-learning ability, self-evaluation, design thinking and agile working methodologies.

# SOCIAL PROJECTION OF THE SOLIDARITY FOOD TRUCK

**SECTOR** · Community aid

**LOCATION** · El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras.

**DESCRIPTION** · In Honduras, the levels of poverty and illiteracy are worrisome, as well as the political situation, which is worsening since the 2017 elections. Not even the aid coming from the Spanish cooperation is reaching the country.

In 2019, with the collaboration of Fundación NACAR, Educasa, KPMG Foundation and Elecnor

we built a Solidarity Food Truck for the dual vocational training for the School of Glass students of Cuisine and Tourism.

**This project has 3 objectives:**

- **Dual education**
- **Awareness and communication** of the work carried out and the need for access to education
- **Social projection** with children's centers and nursing homes

In 2019 we started this social action celebrating Solidarity Week, bringing the Food Truck to orphanages and nursing homes. We work to embed the value of solidarity in the young students of the School of Glass so they learn that you don't necessarily need money to help others but with your knowledge and your good will you can also do a lot.

**DESCRIPTION** · Education for all EDUCATODOS is a Program of the Secretariat of Education, under agreement No. 522-0436, signed between the United States of America and the Republic of Honduras.

It is a program designed by professional Hondurans for the absent and excluded

population of the school system, based on the National Basic Education Curriculum, which ensures the achievement of learning using an interactive methodology.

It is a Program with a modality that provides access to basic education services in shorter term than the traditional system. Through the School of Glass project, we have joined the Honduran effort in literacy of the elders of the communities We serve and unite education in values for the young students of this school.

Being this, they are the young students of the School of Glass those who volunteer in the EDUCATODOS program teaching how to read and write to their elders.
